FARRIER:

RULES: AERC and UMECRA. Endurance will be a gate-into-hold and Competitive will be UMECRA window concept. AERC and UMECRA rules regarding sponsors for juniors will be followed. ALL JUNIORS MUST WEAR HELMETS. Condensed Competitive and Endurance Rules can be found on the Great Lakes Distance Riding Association website, www.gldrami.org (Riding Rules).

All rides are open to any equine. Tentative starting time will be 6:00 a.m. each day. Vet-in for Saturday rides will be Friday late afternoon/evening; Sunday rides, Saturday late afternoon/evening.

AWARDS: There will be completion awards for each rider. The AHAM Traveling Trophy will be awarded to the high-point horse in the 75-Mile Competitive Ride. There will be an award for Best Condition in the Endurance and LD Rides. Breed awards as donated; however, registration papers must be presented at check-in to be eligible for breed awards. Special awards for *FUN* rides.

RIDE LOCATION: Cheff Therapeutic Riding Center, 8450 N 43rd Street, Augusta, MI. See map on other side. For more information on the Cheff Center, go to www.cheffcenter.org.

TRAIL: Trails consist of Cheff Center, Battle Creek Hunt Club, Kellogg Forest, and private properties. A variety of single-track, two-track, forest roads, some rock, flat, and hills. Very little water on trail, but easy access for crews or self-crewing. All vet checks in camp.

CAMP: A large field with space available on a first-come basis. Horse water available. No camping fee! **ALL DOGS MUST BE LEASHED-NO EXCEPTIONS!**

FOOD: Saturday evening potluck prior to Awards Presentation (main course provided by ride management).
