This ride is held at Horserider's Campground in Palmyra, WI. This is a DNR campground with water and restrooms on site. Because this is a state-owned park, a nightly camping fee, vehicle, and trail pass are required. Self-registration is required, pay as you enter campground. Dogs are allowed, must be on a leash. Campsites have level parking pads and posts for picket lines. Electric pens are allowed, but must be in the picket line area. Please read camp rules as you enter. More info on back.
