The trails of the Northern Kettle Moraine Forest offer a wide variety of terrain and scenery – everything from grassy, rolling open spaces to wooded areas with challenging hills. Parts of trail are rocky – shoes recommended. We do as many checks as possible out of camp so you see lots of the trail – crew bag shuttle service offered/water at checks. Come enjoy one of the oldest and most beautiful 100 mile rides in the AERC!

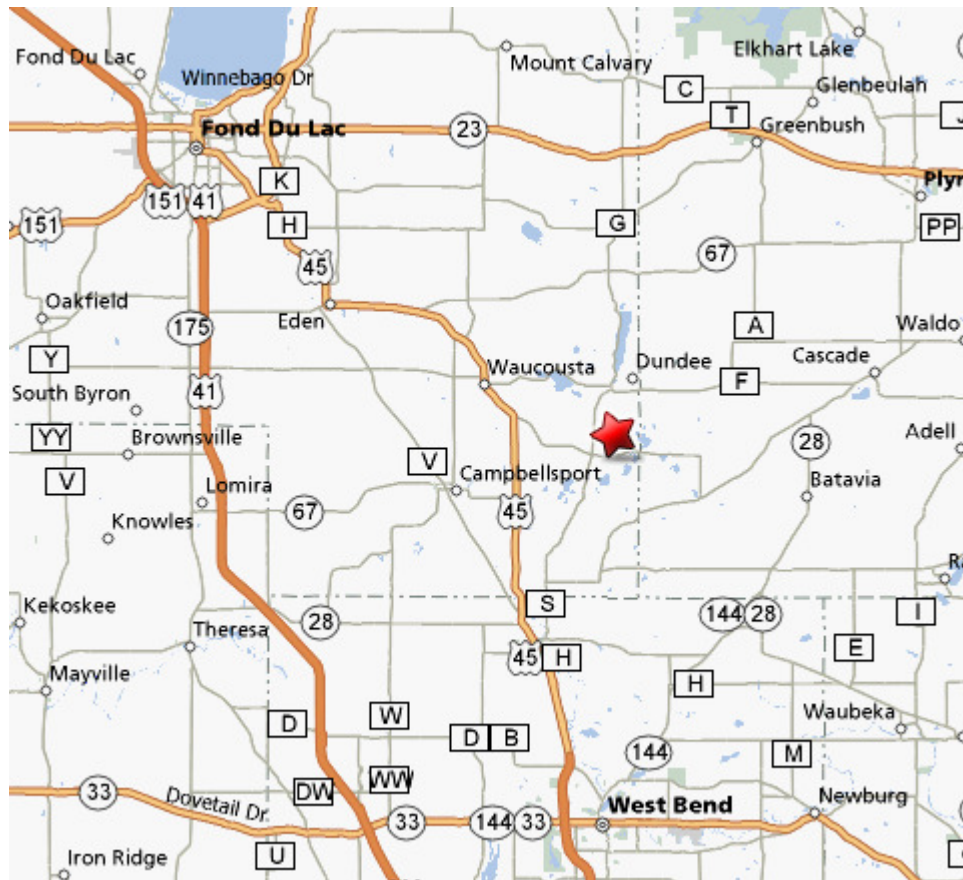

Day parking available that does NOT require reservations.

There are 21 individual sites available for overnight camping that can be reserved by going to:

1. <http://www.reserveamerica.com/campsiteSearch.do>
  2. Click on the Campgrounds by Map tab
  3. Click on WISCONSIN (there is a US map on here) and you want the WI map only
  4. Look for the Fond du Lac pin (look underneath Lake Winnebago). Each campground on the map is located by a 'pin' – looks like a push-pin on a paper map.
  5. Click on the Fond du Lac pin- it will say "Kettle Moraine SF (Northern)
  6. On the 'bubble' that shows up- click on the SEE DETAILS button- this takes you to the campground in the Northern Kettle area (there are several of them).
  7. Use the drop down window and click on NEW PROSPECT- this is the horseman's camp.
  8. The blue horse heads are the available sites. The 'brown/orange ones are reserved'
- The cost is \$12/night plus a reservation fee.**
