- \$15 AERC non-member fee (End or LD).
- NEGATIVE COGGINS REQUIRED – bring copy for management.
- No Fee’s returned after vet-in.
- State Forest Camping Fee Required – No reservations needed, pay at camp.
- Camping may be close, come prepared to camp close to your neighbors.
- No Ties allowed in Endurance or LD.
- There will be ONE single file line for LD completions and placings. Pulse box option at ½ way check.

THE FUN STUFF:

- Sandwiches and snacks will be provided at Vet Stops during Saturday rides!
- Ride Award Donations from your favorite horse shops!
- Dinner provided at Saturday evening awards, please bring a side or dessert to share **if you wish**.
- Exciting trail changes! Including some fun single track trail additions.
- 5 mile “FUN RIDE” offered after awards on Saturday night. For those of you aspiring to ride a 100 but are worried about riding in the dark or those who just love to ride at night. For fun only! Trail will be glow sticked and led by experienced night rider and horse(s)

To get to Pillsbury State Forest Horse Camp -

From Brainerd: 10 miles west of 371 & 210 intersection to Pillsbury State Forest Road go North (left) about 3.5 miles. *Watch for sign on 210 to Outback Riding Stable.*

From Pillager: 1 mile east Hwy 210 to Pillsbury State Forest Road go North (right) about 3.5 miles. *Watch for sign on 210 to Outback Riding Stable. DO NOT take Hwy 1 North off of Hwy 210 in Pillager!* There is a sign that says to Pillsbury State Forest, but it is for PEOPLE camp!
