HELPFUL RIDER HINT #46

Maintain the same horse name on all ride entries - whether barn name, registered name, or part of registered name. It's difficult for points keepers and mileage trackers if the barn name is used on one ride entry, and the registered name is used in a entry ride a month later. This way all your points and mileage if on one horse, go to the same horse! If there's been a dual listing contact the UMECRA points keeper, Barb Gardner ASAP at barb@doublebarallc.com

HELPFUL RIDER HINT #93

My non-horsey husband gave me a great idea (sometimes he's more than a hat rack!)

Not a "ride" thing, but very well could be.

My older gelding had a situation that I had to administer bute for several days. I use a dosing syringe with applesauce for medication so I know he's getting it.

I was complaining that whenever I open a new jar of applesauce, I only end up using a little bit, then it sits for months, gets moldy, and I have to pitch it.

His suggestion was to get those single-serving lunch cups, the kind with the peel off foil top. A perfect little cup for mixing in my bute ; actually, one cup is enough for about 3 doses.

I can keep it in the barn (or trailer), and pitch when I'm done. I think this will work great for electrolytes at rides.

Results Reporting. Also, I found out that AERC doesn't care if the riders names are reported "last name first," so that means that you can copy and paste the results from the UMECRA spread sheet to the AERC spread sheet - and you don't have to retype the names.

The UMECRA pointskeeper really PREFERS that you report your results electronically. It really makes no sense for you to use the spread sheet provided and not send it in electronically. Why should the time be spent to type your results twice. I, for one, had difficulty using the on line reporting procedure supplied on the AERC web page last year, so I called the AERC office and asked if they had a problem with receiving the results on my spread sheet (which mimics the AERC hard copy), and was told that they were perfectly happy to receive them via e-mail on my spread sheet. If you no longer have the spread sheets I provided you with last year, please e-mail me (Elinore) and I will send them to you.
