## **Additional Awards**

#### **UMECRA Senior Equine Award** -

Donated by Sharon Hahn

This award honors the equine 20 years of age and older that accrues the highest number of UMECRA points + UMECRA miles during the season. The equine may compete in multiple divisions (endurance, limited distance, competitive, novice, driving) and with any number of riders. The equine must complete at least 4 rides to be eligible. Owners need to nominate their horse by sending their nomination form to Sharon Hahn accompanied by proof of age (registration papers or vet letter or other evidence for unregistered animals). There is no fee to nominate.

To qualify, complete the Senior Equine Nomination Form (available on the UMECRA website) and send it to Sharon Hahn as indicated on the form.

#### **UMECRA Riders Choice Award**

Originating in 1981 this award is presented annually at the UMECRA Convention & Awards Banquet following a vote from those members that are present at the convention.

The guidelines to be considered when nominating and voting for a horse for this honor are:

- A horse that has shown superior ability in its division
- A horse that has been a consistent competitor
- A horse that has shown its ability to overcome setbacks
- Any horse, for any reasons the nominator admires, and feels is a superior representative of the "Distance Horse"

### **UMECRA Rules**

## **Proposed Changes**

Please take a few minutes to review the following rule changes that are being proposed for the upcoming annual meeting. The proposals will be reviewed during the meeting and voted on by the designated ride delegates.

## 2023 UMECRA Bylaw Change Proposal – Requires 2/3rds approval

#### ARTICLE VIII MEMBERSHIP

Section 1. ELIGIBILITY. Membership in this organization shall be limited to active members only. Such active memberships shall be granted to individuals, to families and to endurance and/or competitive trail rides.

- (a) All persons shall be eligible for an individual membership.
- (b) Family memberships shall consist of one or more related, or coupled as significant other, adults and/or children of such adults who are less than 18 years of age, all of whom reside in the same household.
- (c) Endurance and/or competitive rides shall be granted a membership on proper application approved by the Board of Directors.
- (d) Each member shall abide by the rules and regulations established by the corporation.

Section 2. DUES. No endurance or competitive trail ride, individual, or family shall become an active member of this organization unless or until it/s/he shall first pay to the corporation the annual dues which shall be set by the Board of Directors from time to time.

#### Section 3. RIDER

REPRESENTATIVES. Individual members and family memberships of the corporation shall be entitled to vote for the four Rider Representatives who shall serve as delegates to the annual or special meetings of the corporation. Ride managers are not eligible to be elected as Rider Representatives. Family memberships shall be entitled to as many votes, up to a maximum of two *votes* per family membership as there are adults within the family unit.

#### Rationale

Because UMECRA does not ask for member's ages on annual member forms; a proposed change in the bylaws to match the long-time practice of allowing two votes for family members no matter if the family member is two adults or an adult and a minor member, or multiple family members of different ages. This is for Rider Representative voting.

### 2023 UMECRA Rule Change Proposals Rationale

UMECRA SANCTIONING REQUIREMENTS

- 2. UMECRA RULES
- O. All sanctioning fees must be paid are due\_by Feb. 1st. If not paid by this date, the ride loses sanctioning for the year Sanctioning Coordinator will send an email to the ride manager (call or letter sent by confirmation delivery) and document that contact has been made requesting the funds. Late payments

The current rule for fees not paid by February 1<sup>st</sup> is very rigid, especially if fees are a few days late. The rewrite is a solution which is viewed as more workable by the board and has various penalties laid out within the new rule.

will be considered a re-sanctioning request and must be approved by the Board of Directors. Penalties for late payments may include: delay in the posting of the ride flyer online, exclusion of the flyer from the ride book, and loss of ride sanctioning. It is the ride manager's duty to contact the Sanctioning Coordinator and Treasurer if their contact information has been changed from the previous year.

#### UMECRA ENDURANCE RULE

7. There must be a minimum of two *midride* vet checks on a 50-mile ride and a minimum of three four *midride* checks on a 100-mile ride.

This proposed change bumps up the number of checks required in a 100-mile ride that will match newly adopted UMECRA veterinary guidelines. It also clarifies that the checks listed here are to be midride checks, and not count the "final check" in this total. \*\*This rule if passed will be underlined in our rule book, because it is more strict than AERC, which requires one checkpoint hold in any ride 25 miles or more.

## UMECRA COMPETITIVE RIDE Rules – *Proposed new wording for 3.B:*

3. Rider Requirements

B. Devices which serve strictly as leg protection shall be penalized two points per leg per day. Examples include, but are not limited to bell boots, splint boots, wraps, sleeves or any device that was not manufactured to hold hoof protection in place. All types of hoof protection are permissible, including hoof boots with the manufacturer's associated parts. Boots and parts shall NOT extend above the pastern, or the boot will be subject to the two points per day per leg penalty. The judge may request to observe the area covered by the boot and/or the area under any leg protection at any time. If leg protection is not declared, see (H).

## Current hoof boot rule: COMPETITIVE RULE

3. Rider Requirements

B. If boots, bandages, or wraps are used, the horse shall be penalized two points per leg per day. Boots and their permanent attachments designed to protect the sole of the hoof are permitted, and shall not be penalized. The judges may request to observe the area covered by the attached strap, keeper or gaiter at any time. If boots are not declared, see (H).

H. The penalty for failing to follow the above requirements: completion only, miles only or disqualification. (2014)

Hoof protection continues to evolve in sophistication, and the current rule has caused at least some confusion at one ride. Some boots have attachments that are designed to be changed out, so they are not permanent. A different boot may have a similar strap, and be permanent but not penalized.

In an effort to not to discriminate against certain hoof boot brands, <u>leg protection</u> is defined and penalty points are taken. This has been the long time practice of UMECRA and other competitive trail groups. <u>Hoof protection</u> is also defined and defined what is acceptable.

Hoof protection that extends above the pastern is either not allowed by other competitive trail organizations or it is given penalty points as described in this rule.
