The recipient is chosen by the AHDRA Executive Board and is announced at the UMECRA awards banquet. Nominations for the award should be directed to the AHDRA President by December 1.

There are 4 Rider Representative positions open for a 2 -year term starting in 2024. This is a great position for those who want to serve as a connection between riders and the Board.

- A Rider Representative must be a 2+ year UMECRA member at least 18 years of age who has been elected to serve the on the Board of Directors by individual and family members. They are also delegates to the annual and special meeting(s).
- Ride managers are **not** eligible to be elected as Rider Representatives.
- Interested members need to create a write up with a description of who they are and why they would like to represent their fellow distance riders. You can nominate yourself or someone else.
