### Wildrock County Park (Near Neillsville, Wisconsin)

Weather can have an effect on the starting times. Try to get to the ride the night before the event so you won't be disappointed. We will get you vetted in, no matter how early the ride starts.

**Trails:** The terrain is pretty flat, some rolling hills on a combination of 2-track and single track trails. Natural water crossings and tanks provided. Lots of road crossings for endurance crewing.

**Camping Facilities:** There is water and electric on 20 sites, but camping is tight. Be prepared to be friendly with your neighbors. Pen size to be approved by management. Creative Camping Contest: best use of camping space will receive a refund of one night camping fee. Camping Fee & Trail Fee: There is a camping fee and a daily use trail fee charged by Clark County.

**Dinner:** POT LUCK DINNER ON Friday Night. Management to provide main dish, bring a dish to pass. ***Coffee every morning.***

**Directions:** Wildrock County Park is located approximately 30 miles North of Black River Falls & 15 miles East of Osseo. You might want to fill up with gas & Ice before you get to camp. 10 miles to town.

***From the South:*** Exit I-94 at Black River Falls. Take Hwy 12 North through Humbird (17.5 miles) Stay on 12/27 another 5 miles on Hwy 10. Turn East (Right) on Hwy 10 for barely the length of your rig. Turn North (Left) on County I. Stay on I for about 10 miles. Watch for Ride Signs. Turn Right on Bald Peak Forest Road. Camp is on your Right.

***From the North:*** Exit I94 at Osseo. Take Hwy 10 East approximately 14 miles to County I. Turn North (left) on County I for 10 miles. Watch for Ride Signs. Turn Right on Bald Peak Forest Road. Camp is on your Right.
