AWARDS: Completion awards to all who finish. Appropriate placing awards in all weight divisions

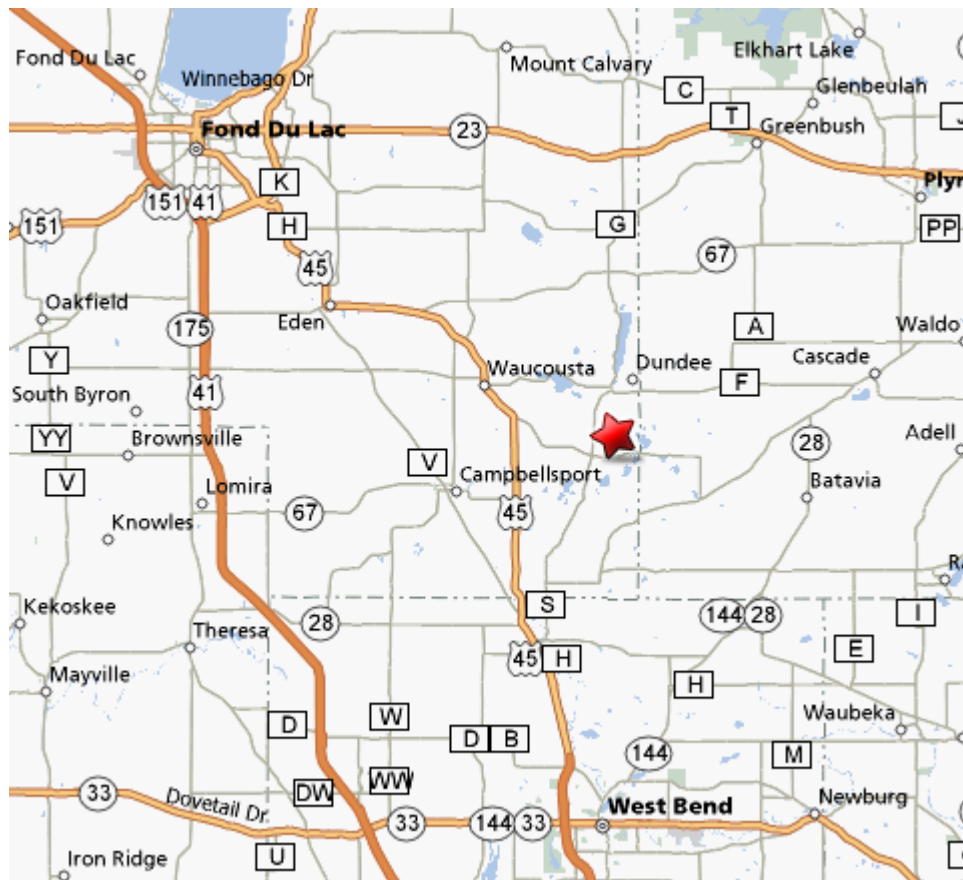

There are 21 individual sites available that can be reserved by going to:

1. [kws=22z z z 1uhvuyhdp hulfd1frp 2fdp svlvhVhdufk1gr](http://kws=22z z z 1uhvuyhdp hulfd1frp 2fdp svlvhVhdufk1gr)
  2. Click on the Campgrounds by Map tab
  3. Click on WISCONSIN (there is a US map on here) and you want the WI map only
  4. Look for the Fond du Lac pin (look underneath Lake Winnebago) Each campground on the map is located by a 'pin' – looks like a push-pin on a paper map.
  5. Click on the Fond du Lac pin- it will say "Kettle Moraine SF (Northern)
  6. On the 'bubble' that shows up- click on the SEE DETAILS button- this takes you to the campground in the Northern Kettle area (there are several of them).
  7. Use the drop down window and click on NEW PROSPECT- this is the horseman's camp.
  8. The blue horse heads are the available sites. The 'brown/orange ones are reserved'
- The cost is \$12/night plus a reservation fee.**
