## **Northern Highland**

The Northern Highland ride has moved 100 miles east to beautiful Florence County. Enjoy wooded, equestrian-specific trails developed by a local club. The trail surface is predominantly grass and dirt with some dirt/gravel road riding to get between the trails. Camping is rustic. Horse water will be provided in camp. Bring a dish to pass for Saturday night potluck. Awards will be on Saturday night and Sunday afternoon after the rides.

**Camping Fee:** \$10.00 per rig per night

**Ribbons will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> Heavyweight, Lightweight, and Junior for competitive and endurance; 1<sup>st</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> (no divisions) for limited distance. Completions for all who finish.**

**Sanctioned by AERC, UMECRA, & DRAW.** Pre-ride vet checks begin the evening before and early morning. Rider's meeting Friday and Saturday evening before rides. Sponsors required for each minor, including novice ride participants.

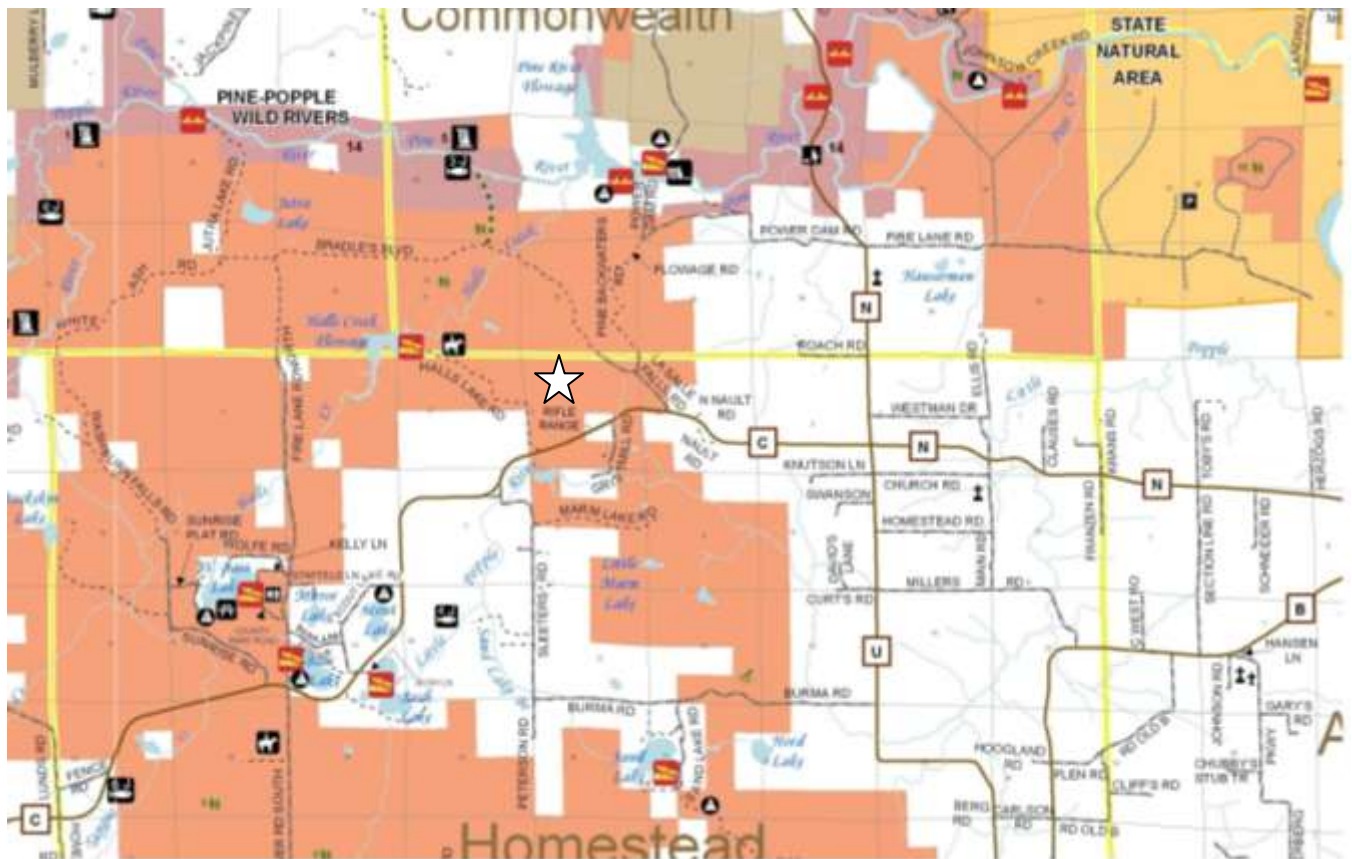

## Directions:

From the south (Green Bay): Take 141 North towards Iron Mountain, MI. When you arrive in Niagara, WI stay straight and follow County Road N (141 goes to the right). Stay on County Road N through Aurora, WI and you will eventually reach a stop sign the intersection of County Roads N and C. Go straight at the stop sign to follow County Road C. Camp will be on the right hand side approximately 2.5 miles from the stop sign at the Rifle Range. Look for signs.

From the east (Escanaba): Follow US-2 west to Florence, WI. Turn left on County Road N. At the stop sign, the intersection of N and C, turn right on County Road C. Camp will be on the right hand side approximately 2.5 miles from the stop sign at the Rifle Range. Look for signs.

From the west (Minoqua): Take Hwy 70 east to Florence, WI. Turn right on US-2 east. Turn right on County Road N in town. At the stop sign, the intersection of N and C, turn right on County Road C. Camp will be on the right hand side approximately 2.5 miles from the stop sign at the Rifle Range. Look for signs.
