Directions: (from North)

Take I-74 East to Peoria. Take Exit 32—IL-17, Woodhull/Alpha exit. Follow IL-17 to Aledo. At stoplight in Aledo (big court-house or something on SE corner) take IL-94 south (later turns into 2650 N or CR-3). Go approximately 6 miles to 30th Ave—turn right. Follow through Seaton and turn left at 100th Street (changes to 1500 N at county line; you will go about 9 miles south). Go about four miles after turning on 100th St—PAST the Keithsburg/Big River Equestrian campground. Camp is on the right. Pull in first (north) drive and park anywhere—we use the big open field for trot-outs and vetting. Trail head is in southwest corner of campground.
